Three themes the Club will explore are the following:

Indigenous Podcasts for Kids - April 6

How do we amplify Indigenous voices and knowledge systems in our classrooms? How can we integrate Indigenous perspectives into the learning we are already doing? How can learning be a jumping off point for action? In this series of podcasts, we will explore familiar topics presented through an Indigenous framework, with Indigenous voice. We will compare different approaches to the same learning and reflect on how we might bring this learning to our students.

Indigenous Changemakers - May 11

How can we learn about community building and Indigenous identities from Indigenous changemakers? What is the role of storytelling and literature in decolonizing spaces? Listen to Indigenous feminists, artists and two-spirited academics unapologetically share their experiences and hopes for the future of Indigeneity in Canada.

The Land, Treaties and Land Acknowledgments - June 1

What does land mean to Indigenous communities? What connects us all to the land? How can treaties help Indigenous communities and Canadians respect the land and live in harmony as was intended in the early treaties? These questions and more will be reflected on and examined in these podcasts.
